Artist Invitation: Logo Design Opportunity

A Healing and Cultural Lodge

Taykwa Tagamou Nation invites local TTN artists to create an original, non-AI-generated logo for Veronica Archibald Kamik, “A Healing and Cultural Lodge.”

The logo should reflect the Lodge as a place of healing, culture, land, wellness, learning, and community. The final design will be used on signage, reports, posters, social media, clothing, and other Lodge materials.

Traditional, digital, and mixed-media artwork are welcome. All artwork must be original, created by the artist, and not generated using artificial intelligence.

This opportunity is open to Taykwa Tagamou Nation artists. All original visual styles are welcome.

About the Lodge

Veronica Archibald Kamik is being developed by Taykwa Tagamou Nation as a land-based healing and cultural learning program for First Nation clients.

The Lodge will bring together culture, land-based activities, clinical care, community support, and wrap-around services. Its approach recognizes culture, land, family, community, language, ceremony, and belonging as essential parts of healing.

Ideas for the Logo

Artists may draw inspiration from:

- Land as healer and teacher.
- Balance of spirit, heart, mind, and body.
- First Nation knowledge, language, ceremony, and teachings.
- Hope, belonging, family, community, and care.
- The Cree Six Seasons: Pipon, Sikwan, Mithoskamin, Nipin, Takwakin, and Mikiskaw.
- Nature, renewal, water, medicines, wildlife, gathering, and the changing seasons.
- Learning across generations through youth, Elders, stories, language, and teachings.
- Healing, strength, safety, respect, and hope.
- Taykwa Tagamou Nation’s identity and traditional territory.



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Submission Requirements

Please include:

- Your name and contact information.
- A short artist biography or statement.
- Confirmation that the artwork is original, non-AI-generated, and does not copy another design.
- Your original artwork for the Logo in digital format.

Submissions will be considered based on:

- Connection to the Lodge's purpose.
- Respectful use of cultural ideas and teachings.
- Originality and creativity.
- Clarity and memorability of the design.
- Relevant experience or examples of previous work.
- Ability to revise and finalize the selected concept.

The selected artist will provide a short explanation of the meaning behind each concept, one final logo incorporating feedback and Final files suitable for print and digital use.

Recognition and Compensation

The successful artist will receive a monetary contribution for their artwork and will be recognized on a plaque at the Healing Lodge and on the TTN website.

Ownership and Use

The final logo will be used by Taykwa Tagamou Nation for Veronica Archibald Kamik. Ownership, usage rights, and artist credit will be confirmed with the selected artist.
